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## WELCOME TO CHEYENNE STING!

Cheyenne Sting is the name of the Advanced Program of the Cheyenne Soccer Club. This program is organized to provide a competitive soccer experience, promoting the highest standards of youth athletics including player and team development and promote a higher level of fitness. Cheyenne Sting strives to cultivate a love for the game of soccer among players, coaches, parents, and other interested members of the community.

Tryouts are held in late spring. All players must tryout. If they are unable to attend a regularly scheduled tryout, they may petition to have an individual tryout. The decision to allow this is at the discretion of the Director of Coaching. Players are obligated to the team for both fall and spring sessions. The team coach and the Director of Coaching make the decision on player placement. This decision is final.

Players may play up only if grade appropriate. Exceptions can be made if necessary to complete a roster or when age groups are combined. The Advanced Program Committee has the final decision on approving any exception to the policy.

All Sting teams are encouraged to represent Cheyenne in the Wyoming State Cup. If a team chooses not to play in the Wyoming State Cup, they are required to play in at least one full-sided summer tournament. Sting will pay up to the cost of State Cup registration for one tournament per team per year.

Should a player have a concern, it should first be addressed with the Head Coach of the team. If the problem cannot be resolved, it is then addressed with the Director of Coaching. If there is still no resolution, the matter will be addressed by the Sting Committee, (Advanced Committee of Cheyenne Soccer Club), with recommendation to the Executive Committee of Cheyenne Soccer Club. The decision of the Executive Committee is final.

Playing time will depend on game and team situations. Playing time is at the discretion of the coach. Please make sure you understand the coaches policy on playing time in advance of the season. Coaches should attempt to play each player in each half of each game, provided the player has been responsible in attending practices and games. Players are to be responsible for attending all practices and games, and are expected to show up on time.

Players need to be picked up promptly after practice. The Cheyenne Soccer Club is a volunteer organization; all families are expected to contribute time to Cheyenne Soccer Club and the Advanced Program (Sting). Each team is to designate a parent manager(s) to arrange uniform purchases, scheduling, rostering, etc. In addition, each team is to provide a parent volunteer to the Advanced Committee of the Cheyenne Soccer Club (Sting) to assist with projects and policies. Each team should have a treasurer. Each player's parent should have a job! We rely on volunteers to keep Sting and competitive soccer available to soccer players in Cheyenne. Players and parents are always welcome to attend meetings of Cheyenne Sting and Cheyenne Soccer Club. We appreciate your suggestions and assistance. Be involved in a positive way.

**U11 – U14 GIRLS AND BOYS:        \$500.00**

**PAYMENT PLANS**

- \$500 at registration
- \$250 at registration & \$250 in January
- \$100 at registration & \$100 a month for the next 4 months – credit or debit card only

**Refund Policy- U11 – U14 based on full payment**

- \$450 refund before Aug. 1<sup>st</sup>
- \$400 refund before second game – played in the fall
- No refund after second game

**U15 – U18 GIRLS: \$300.00 (FOR FALL SESSION ONLY)**

**PAYMENT PLANS**

- \$300 at registration
- \$100 at registration & \$100 a month for the next 2 months – credit or debit card only

**Refund Policy- U15 & ABOVE based on full payment**

- \$250 refund before Aug. 1<sup>st</sup>
- \$200 refund before second game
- No refund after second game

Scholarships (1/2 of the fee) are available on a limited basis. To apply for a scholarship, contact the Registrar. Recipients of scholarships are asked to volunteer to help their team or the Sting Committee.
