## *Registration open for the Fall 2011 Season!*

Registrations for the Fall 2011 / Spring 2012 Recreational season is now opened.

Register on-line by clicking on "Cheyenne Soccer Club Registration" in the upper right-hand corner to access our on-line registration system.

We will also have an in-person registration with a limited number of computers available at the North Cheyenne Community Park Storage Shed - Saturday, May 21st from 8am - 1pm. Then again on Thursday, July 7th from 5:30pm - 8:00pm.

FEES: Under 10 & above: Fall & Spring-\$70/Fall Only-\$55. Under 6 & Under 8: Fall & Spring-\$55/Fall Only \$47.50.

To guarantee your child a spot on a team this coming fall soccer season and to avoid a \$20 late fee, please register him/her by Friday, July 8th. After Friday, July 8th registrations will only be accepted if there is room in your child's division and a \$20 LATE FEE will be charged.

## *What is involved in playing on a Sting team?*

The Sting soccer program is organized to provide a competitive soccer experience, promoting the highest standards of youth athletics including player and team development and adult leadership. The club strives to cultivate a love for the game of soccer among players, coaches, parents and other interested members of the community.

Sting is great value for a competitive soccer experience, players receive coaching from qualified, licensed coaches along with regular team visits by the Director of Coaching. The

program is geared for players who want to improve their abilities and participate in a highly competitive soccer environment. Almost all of the varsity soccer players on the high school teams in Cheyenne participated in Sting when they were younger.

Sting teams play in the Colorado Youth Soccer Association Competitive League. Teams play 10 games in the fall and 8 games in the spring, half played in Cheyenne and half in Colorado. Most games are played along the front range, but occasion-

ally games can require longer drives. Many families car pool to cut the travel costs and most will tell you that the travel is not overwhelming and the high quality competition is worth the drive.

Placement on a Sting team is done through a competitive, two stage, tryout process. Each spring the CSC holds tryouts to form the most competitive team possible from the players interested in participating on the team. See the article on the front page for information on the tryouts this year.

# CSC SOCCER ACADEMY PROGRAM

Cheyenne Soccer Club prides ourselves on the level of importance we place on developing young players. With the introduction of our Soccer Academy we aim to develop players who are technically capable and provide the player with the platform to be taught all the fundamental aspects of the game without detracting away from players having fun and enjoying the amazing game. The Academy Sessions will also be used as a tool to provide training ideas and knowledge exchange for our recreational and competitive club coaches.

The Academy training will be directed to the developmental age of the player. Sessions will be challenging but achievable, guaranteeing that each player will go home with a raised self esteem. The

Academy will rely on a diverse group of experienced Cheyenne Soccer Coaches include the high school, LCCC, Sting coaches as well as others with the appropriate knowledge. Our coaches will aim to develop individual's technical ability which will result in a player being able to play with more confidence and become more effective. Through the delivery of skills and techniques players will learn to dominate 1v1 situations, perform tricks and turns and become more confident with the ball at their feet. Players will also be taught the fundamental techniques such as dribbling, passing, control and receiving, shooting, defending and heading. Players that are comfortable with the ball at their feet naturally have a better chance of making

good decisions, movement of the ball will make the player an asset to their team. Our coaches will develop a player's individual skill as well as how to combine and play as part of a team. Small sided games will be used to provide players with lots of opportunities to practice skills and turns in game situations. Players will be educated on how to train and prepare for the demands of the game by focusing on the fundamental movements of balance, speed, agility, strength and stamina.

The CSC Soccer Academy targets U9 to U10 boys and girls and their coaches. The cost of the academy is free and may supplement your player's regular team training. Contact Liam Sinclair if you have questions 307-631-2272.

## CSC U10 STINGERS SOCCER

The Cheyenne Stingers program (U10) {birthdates from 8/1/01 - 7/31/02} is a soccer program where participants will travel to Fort Collins, Colorado weekly for games. Stingers players are **required** to attend regular practices, once to 3 times per week (the Youth Academy Directory will conduct at least one weekly practice), and attend scheduled games on Saturday afternoons. Participants may also choose to play in the CSC Recreation League in conjunction with joining the Rec Plus Stingers team.

Please take into consideration your player's ability and soccer experience when registering him/her for the Cheyenne Stingers program. Playing time may vary by ability and other intangibles like practice

attendance, and is at the discretion of the Youth Academy Director. Practice and game times will not conflict with the recreational program for those interested in participating in both. Registrations will be handled on a first come/first serve basis and a waiting list may be available. The registration fee for this competitive program is \$60.00 per season and players will need to purchase their own uniforms.

## ADULT LEAGUE REGISTRATION - NOW OPEN

Adult League will consist of two divisions. Each division will play 12 games, 8 v 8 on a U12 field. We will have division I which will consist of the more experienced players and Division II will consist of the intermediate players.

Each person who registers will be charged \$55 or \$65 if you register after May 31st. Players may also

be asked to help find a sponsor for the sponsorship/team fee. Each team is required to pay a sponsorship/team fee. The sponsorship/team fee will be \$300 per team and must be paid by June 15th or that team will forfeit play.

All players registering late will be assessed a \$10 late fee and may
