REC+ REGISTRATION

Registration for the Fall 2006 Rec+ season occurs on the same dates as CSA registration (see dates below). Rec+ is a CSA developmental soccer program that plays games within the Wyoming State Soccer Association League. Games are competitive in nature and in addition to CSA Saturday games. Games are held on three Sundays in the fall.
