CSA and the Sting Soccer Club boards have both approved a plan in which the two clubs will merge to form the Cheyenne Soccer Club. Both clubs have held public meetings and contacted membership to solicit comments. Key points agreed upon include the initial board membership (10 CSA, 4 Sting, 2 adult) and a financial plan so that each division (recreational and competitive) is independently financially solvent.
