Field Supervisor Information

If you cannot serve as field supervisor during the time you have been assigned it is your responsibility to find a replacement.

Before the start of your scheduled field supervisor duty, please check in at the tournament headquarter tent at least 15 minutes prior to your scheduled time. You will receive an orange vest and your field assignment.

It will be helpful if you have a cell phone when working as a field supervisor. If you do not there will be a cell phone available at the tournament headquarters.

We tried to assign you to supervise the game your team will be playing in. That was not always possible. In most cases you will be supervising 2, and sometimes 3, concurrent games. Please pay attention to all games (not just the one your team is playing in).

FIELD SUPERVISOR DUTIES

Wear the orange vest throughout the time of your assignment.

Check to be sure that the fields are ready for play, with goals set up and flags at playing corners. Filed supervisors assigned to the first shift each day may need to assist with field set-up. Those assigned the last shift on Sunday need to help with field take down. The nets are left up.

Check in with referees and let them know where you will be located during and after games. Be prepared to assist any referee if problems arise with players, coaches or spectators. Always come to the aid of a referee. If the referee(s) are not available 5 minutes before the start of the game notify the field coordinator in the headquarters tent. Referees may be a little late due to scheduling and other games running late. If you know that a referee is on the way please let the coaches know that you have checked and that the referee will be late but is on the way.

When the games are complete, get game score cards from the referee and bring them to the headquarters tent. Remind the referees to return rosters to the coaches.

Monitor the behavior of coaches, players and spectators before and after games. Notify the headquarters tent of any problems.

For medical problems notify the headquarters tent immediately. Please report all injuries, no matter how minor, to the headquarters tent.

If a problem arises please call one of the tournament phone numbers listed above as soon as you can. It will help if you know the field number.

If you have any other problems please notify the headquarters tent.

Check out at the end of the shift. Please be sure to return your vest.

Please be as courteous and helpful as possible to all participants. You are the representative who will have considerable contact with teams, parents and coaches. Your positive actions will help make the tournament a good experience for the players, parents and coaches and will be the impression most teams will have of the tournament.
